## **DISCLOSURE AND CONSENT – LEASING**

When a real estate broker provides real estate brokerage services, Washington law requires the broker to disclose to all parties whether the broker represents the landlord, the tenants, both the landlord and the tenant, or neither. It further requires disclosures regarding terms of any compensation offered by another party or a real estate firm to a real estate firm representing another party. This form should be used when the transaction documents do not otherwise contain these provisions.

1. Agency Disclosure. RCW 18.86.030 requires that a real estate broker disclose to their principal and to all parties in a transaction whether the broker represents the tenant, the landlord, or both parties as a limited dual agent.
